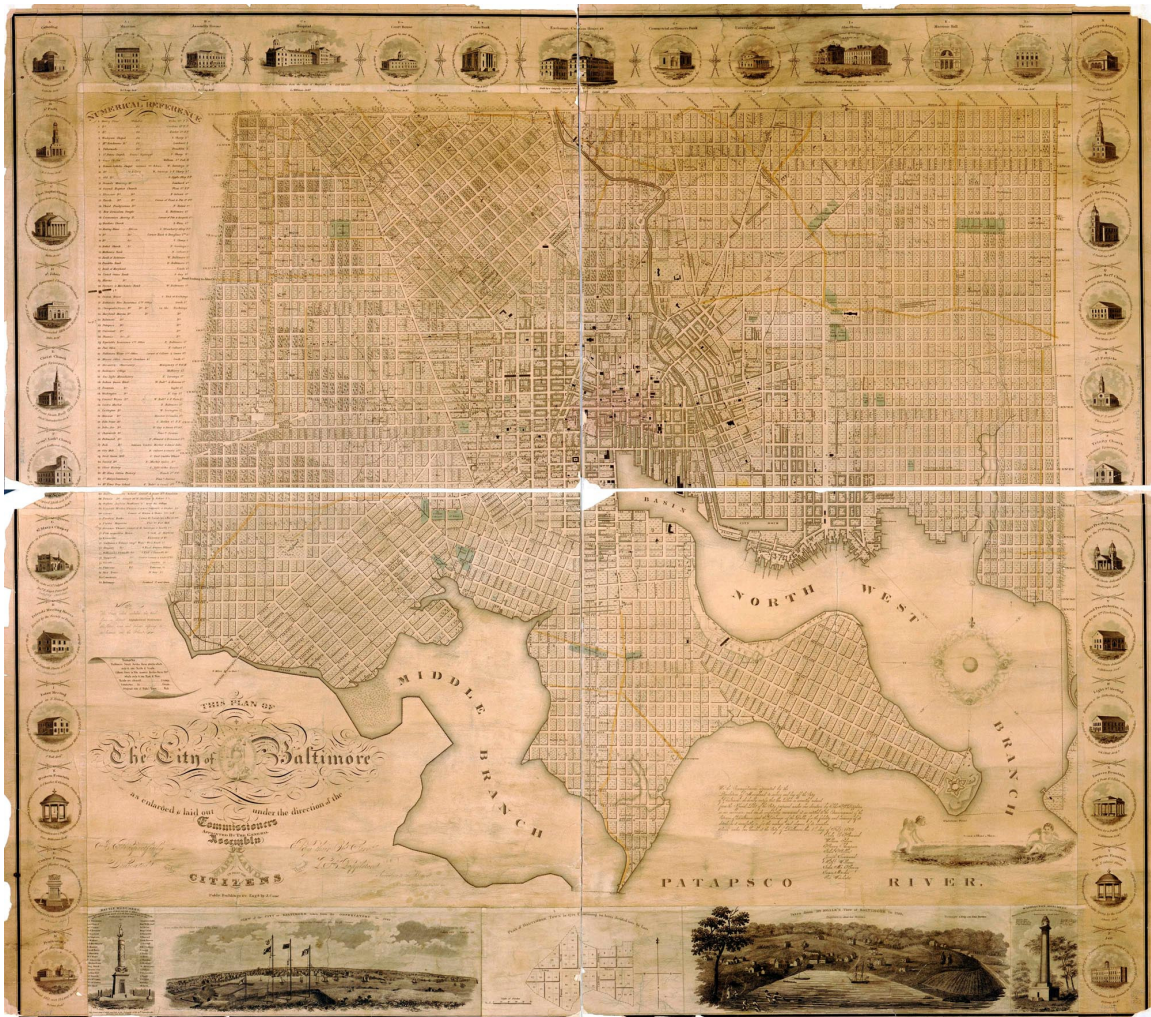

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FIGURE 2: Details from *Plan of the City of Baltimore...*

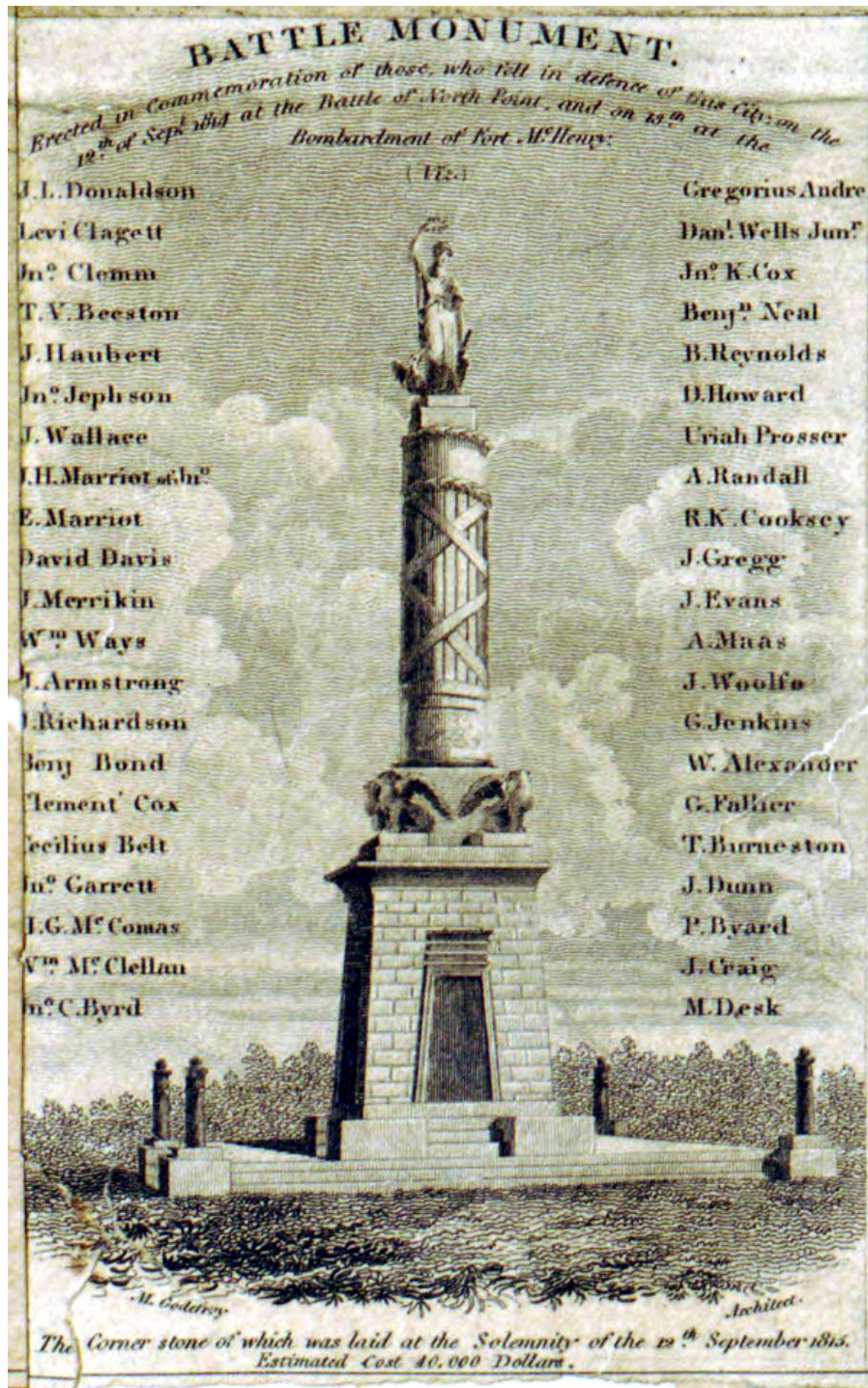

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FIGURE 3: “Battle Monument,” excerpt from *Plan of the City of Baltimore...*

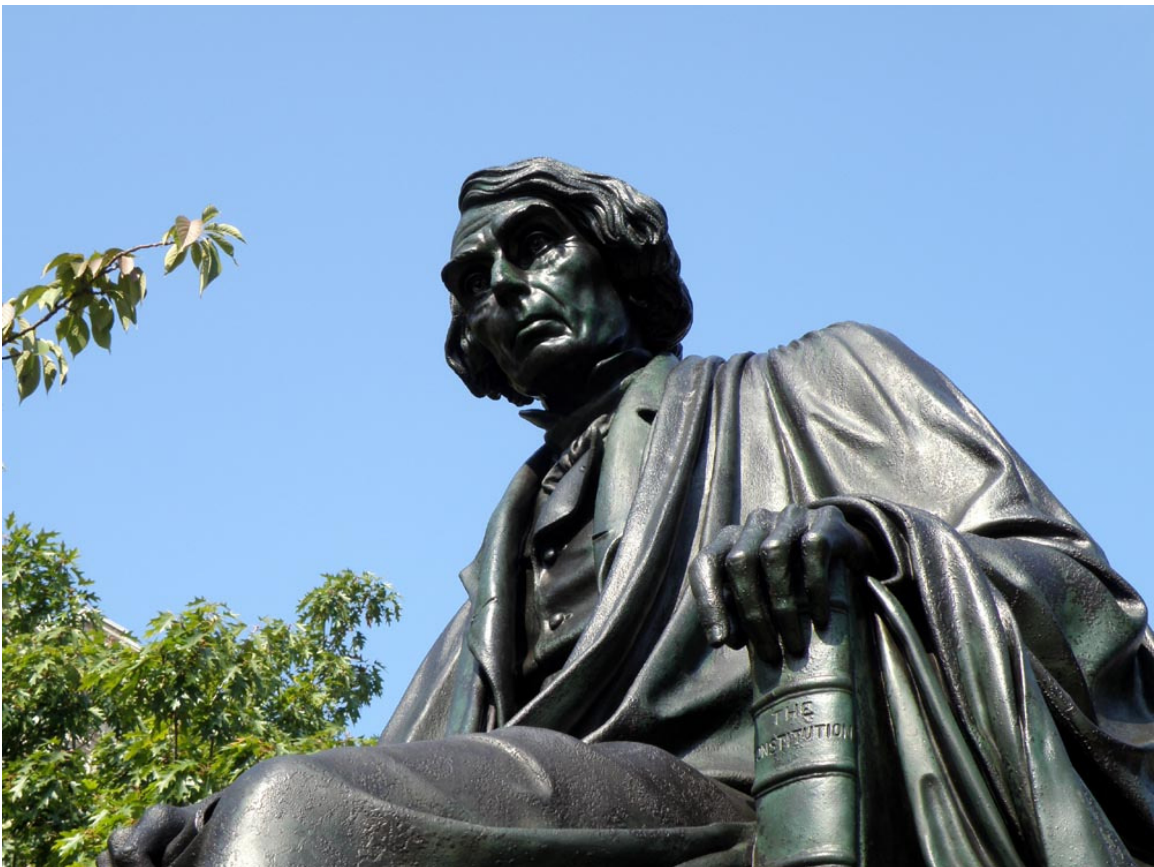

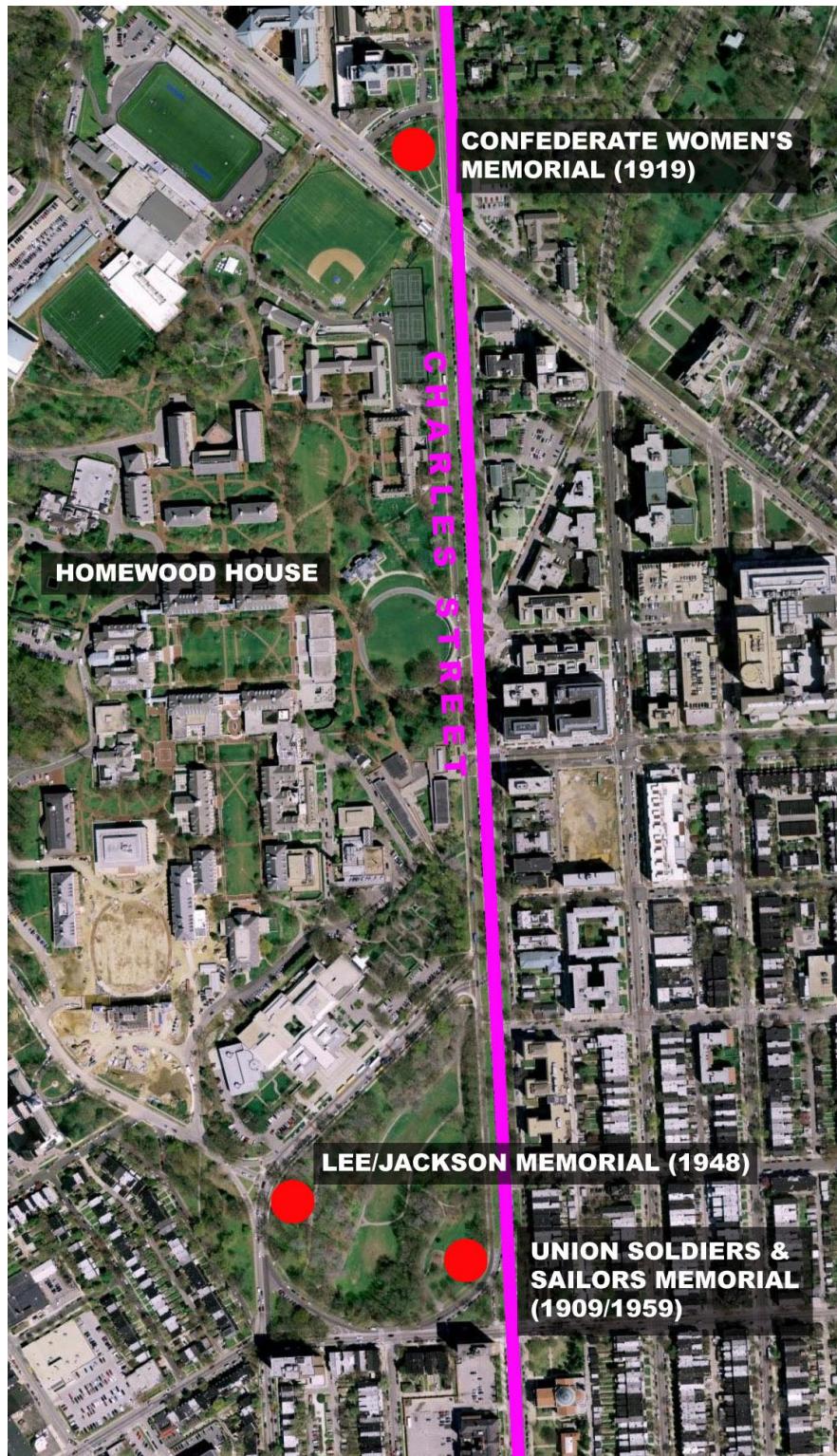

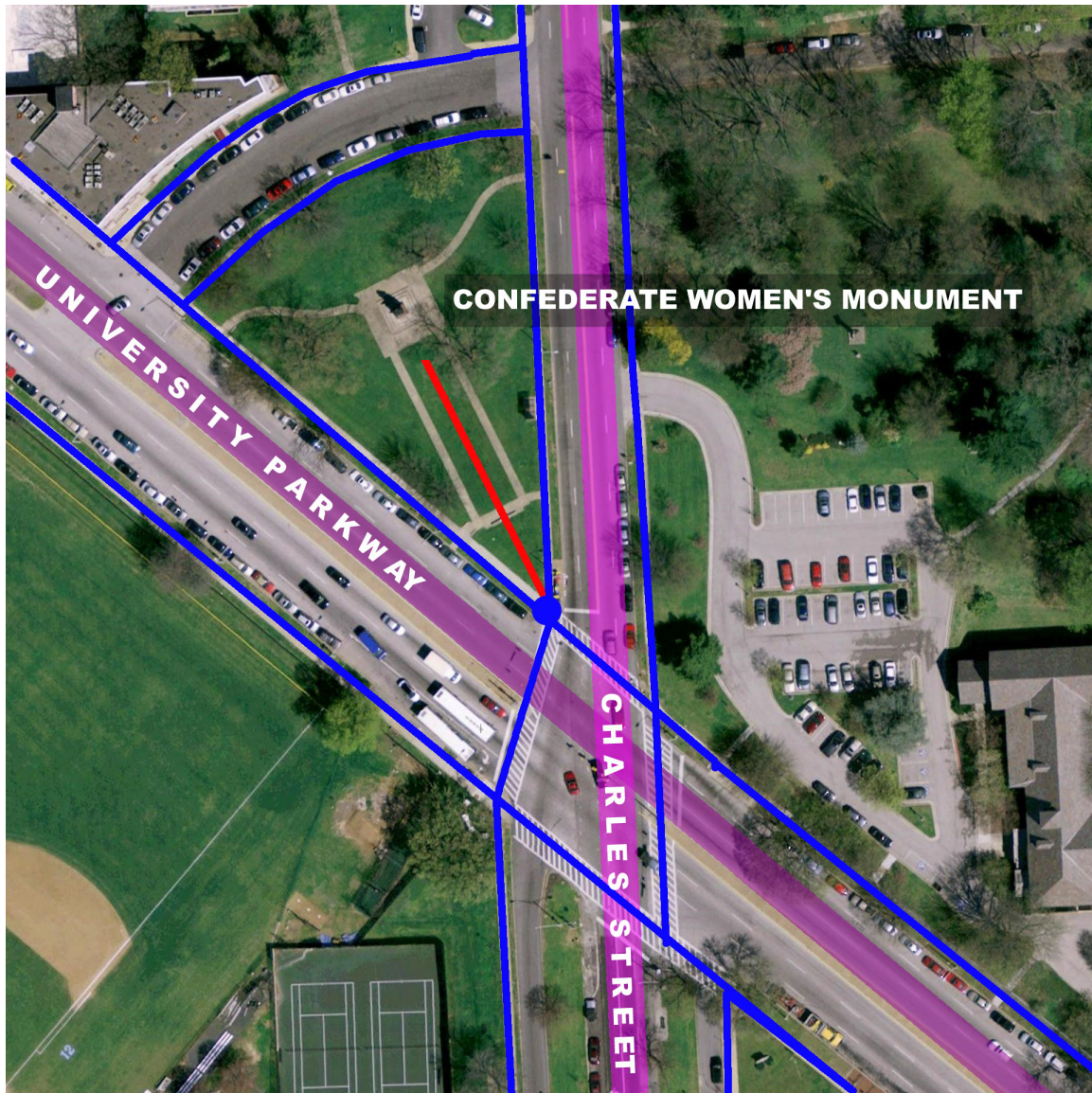

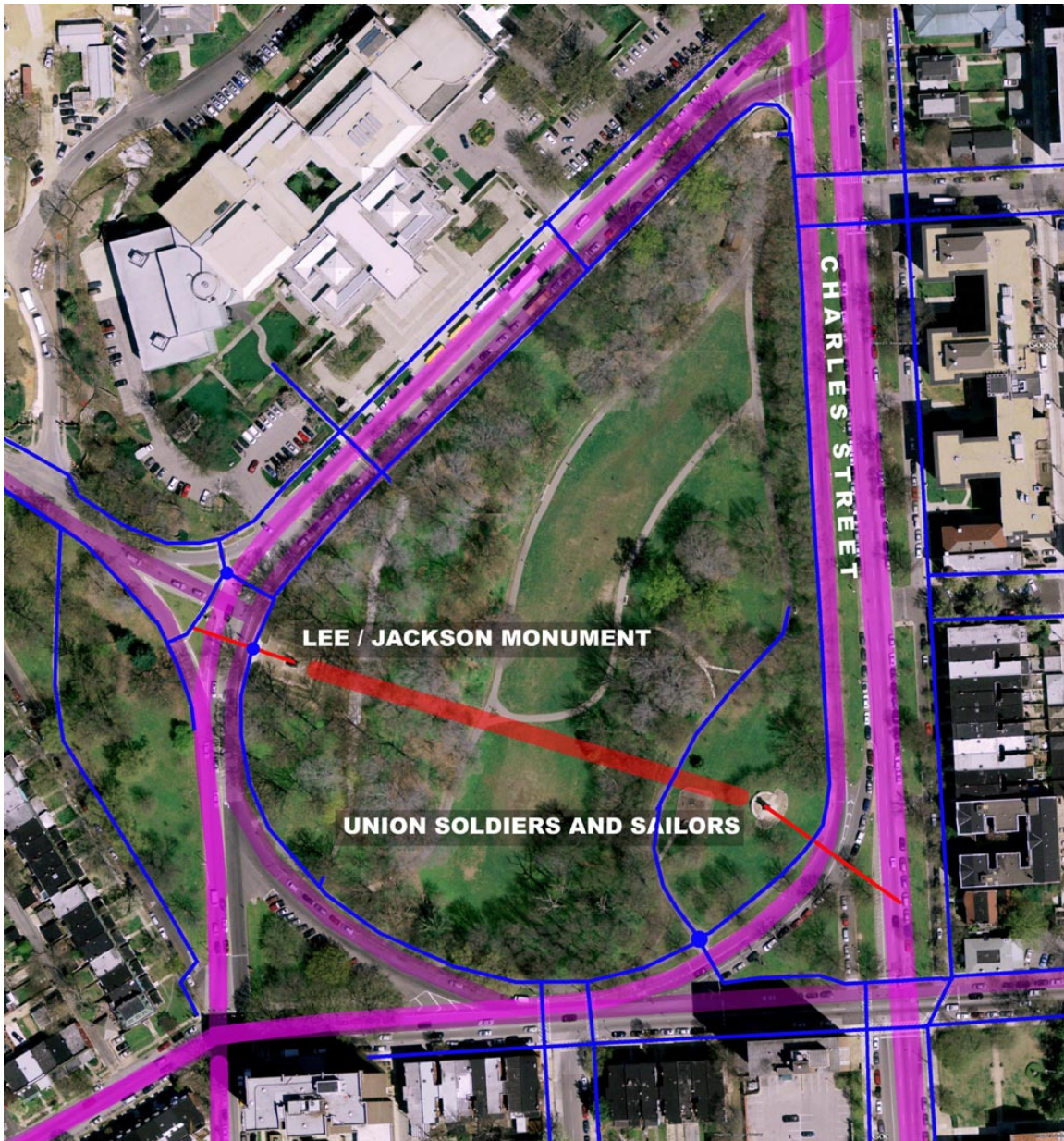

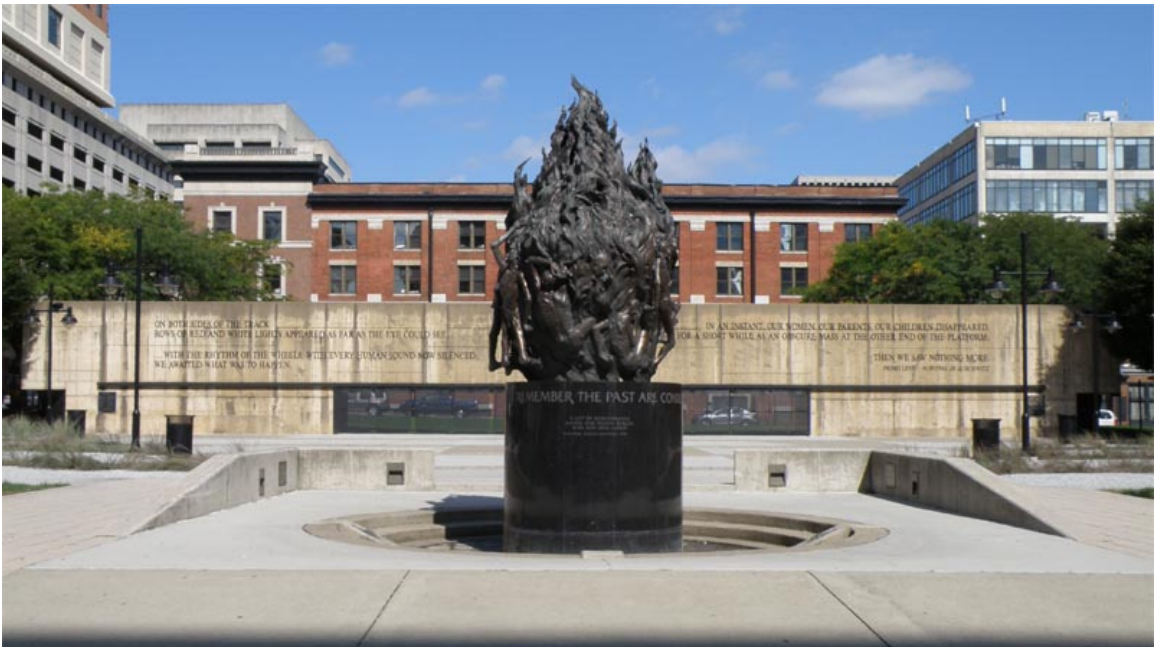

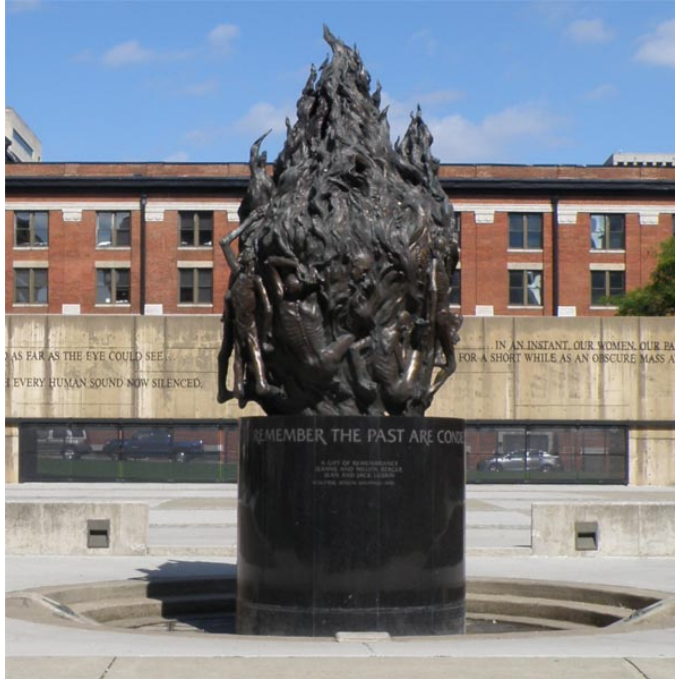

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FIGURE 16: Site Plan for *Baltimore Holocaust Memorial*

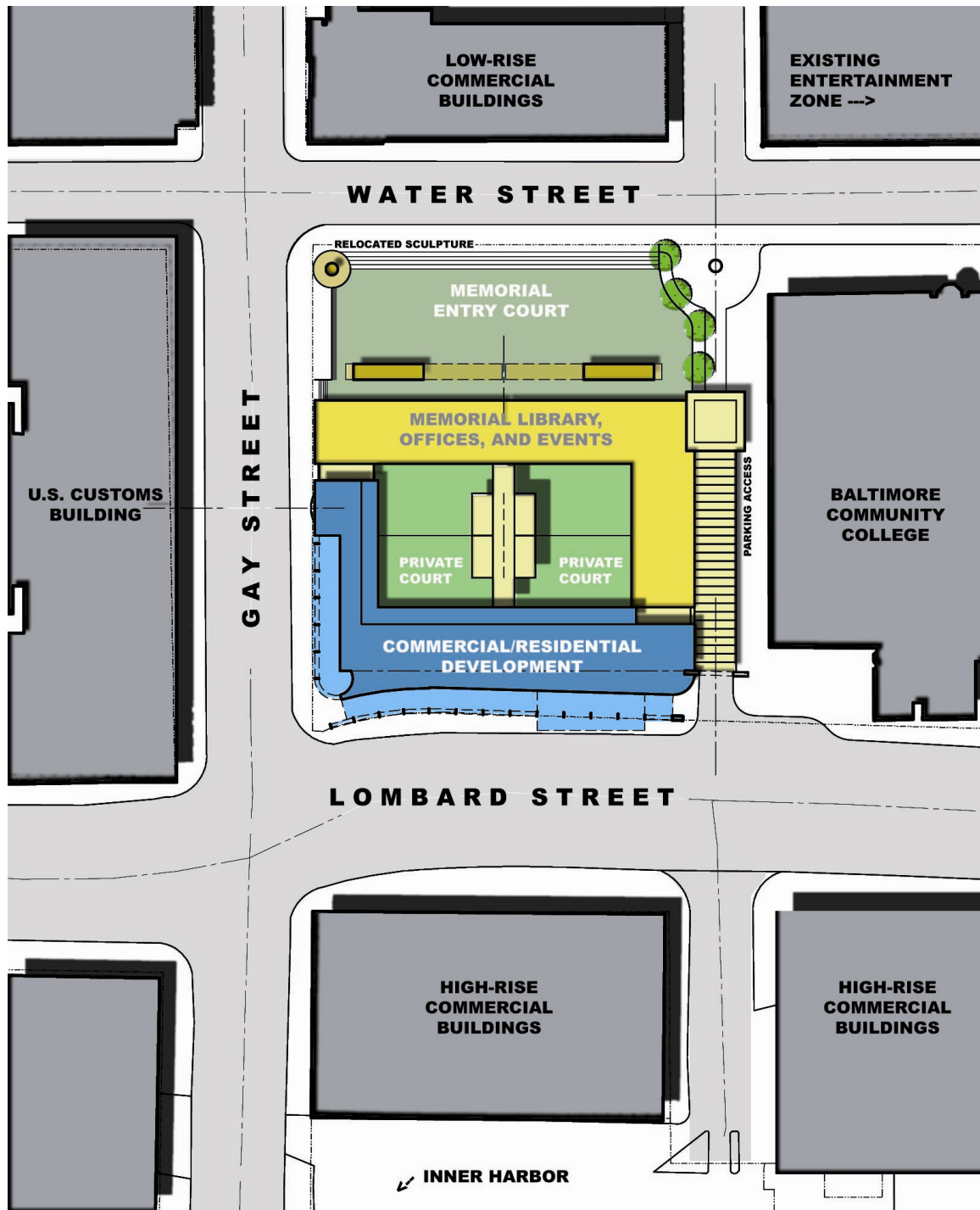
